



LAMMSCAPES!

Caring for your Bareroot Trees & Shrubs

- ⊗ Inspect plant for any broken or rubbing branches. Prune these branches to shape your tree or shrub properly.
- ⊗ It is best to plant tree or shrub as soon as possible. If not planting immediately, keep in cool, moist place and water roots so it does not dry out.
- ⊗ Dig the hole approximately 1 foot wider and 6 inches deeper than the plant's root system. It is important to work up the existing soil and combine it with soil additives, such as peat moss and compost.
- ⊗ Mound topsoil approximately 6 inches in the bottom of the hole.
- ⊗ Backfill existing soil with the compost & peat moss mixture.
- ⊗ Water in tree well with root stimulator solution according to directions on label. Follow-up with root stimulator application again in 2 weeks and then once per month throughout the season.
- ⊗ Stake trees with proper stakes and banding as needed to prevent wind damage.
- ⊗ In the late fall of the first few years protect the tree trunk with a wire mesh tree protector to prevent damage from deer, rabbits, and voles.
